We hope you're enjoying a wonderful start to 2026!

As you prepare for spring quarter, we're back to outline the billing dates and deadlines to be aware of. Please read through this message to learn more about what's coming up this spring.

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### WHAT IS COMING UP FOR SPRING QUARTER?

#### Registrar's Office

- Check the Schedule of Classes to see what's offered and your enrollment appointment time on February 6.
  - Register for upcoming quarter classes beginning February 14.
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- If you're going to be enrolled in 10 units or fewer, consider [applying for part-time study](#) to be eligible for reduced tuition. The deadline to apply is April 10.

### **Housing Dining & Hospitality**

- Spring Quarter marks the end of the 2025-26 housing contract (end date is: **June 13** at 3 p.m. or **September 6** at 3 p.m. for Pepper Canyon West).
    - **9-month contract termination requests must be submitted by May 27.** Billing will be prorated for check out dates that occur not later than **May 30**.
      - Termination requests are not needed for move out dates between **May 30 – June 13**.
      - Per the housing contract, the last two weeks of each quarter are not prorated and all students moving out during that time period will be charged through the end of the quarter. As spring quarter is the end of the academic year, your billing will not be prorated if you decide to move out on or after **May 30**.
      - Please make sure to follow all check out procedures per your Residential Life Office instructions.
    - Pepper Canyon West 25-26 contract holders: May submit termination requests up to **August 28**. You must still meet all housing contract termination criteria as outlined in Section 8.a. Termination by Student. You can find a sample contract here.
  - **Move out-related damage, miscellaneous charges (lost keys) and administrative charges** may be assessed to your student account by your Residential Life Office after performing move out inspections at the end of the academic year. Charges will be assessed to your account no later than **June 30**. If you have charges, you will receive a move out statement via email. You can contact your Residential Life Office for questions regarding any move out damages.
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- **Graduate & Family Housing:** Rent is billed monthly on the first of each month, you can view your bill via TritonPay. TIP! Take the thinking out of paying your monthly rent and set up Autopay via TritonPay.
  - If you have Autopay already set up, log in to verify how many more payments you have left and make sure to update it if it is running out soon so you don't miss any payments.

### **Financial Aid and Scholarships Office**

- Financial Aid funds will be applied toward charges in TritonPay for [eligible students](#) beginning **March 21**. Any excess financial aid will be automatically refunded to the student per the timeline listed in the Student Financial Solutions section.
- Make sure to commence academic activity by participating in your classes by the end of week 2 of spring quarter 2026 to avoid any adjustments to your federal financial aid.

### **Student Financial Solutions (SFS)**

- Re-enroll in the [Triton Registration Installment Plan](#) (TRIP) for the upcoming quarter. **Previous TRIP enrollment does not automatically renew.** Enrollment begins **February 25**. Enroll by **March 20** to take advantage of the early enrollment fee of \$40 and to spread your tuition payments into three monthly installments. TRIP enrollment fee will increase to \$65 after **March 20**.
  - Excess financial aid refunds will be processed beginning on **March 24**.
    - [Enroll](#) in direct deposit to receive your refund within 2-3 business days, much faster and avoids potential delays with paper check.
    - Paper check arrives within 5-7 business days.
  - Don't forget to authorize new payers in [TritonPay](#).
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- The 2025 1098-T is now available. This form reports the tuition and fees you paid to UC San Diego, which may help you or your parents claim an education tax credit when filing taxes. To view your form online, [click here](#).
- If you are sponsored by a third party, please submit your documents using our Third Party Form by **March 20**: [Submit documents here](#). Questions or concerns, check out [our website](#).
- GradGuard Tuition Insurance – an optional safeguard: Available beginning **March 4 through March 24** for Spring Quarter for students who want extra protection for tuition and fees if they need to withdraw for a covered reason. For more information, visit <https://gradguard.com/tuition/ucsd>.
- Students may visit the TritonPay Office for in-person support for all student billing, payment, refund, and campus card inquiries. It is located at Student Services Center 170 and is open Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

### Student Health

- If you missed the Fall health fee waiver deadline or if your insurance coverage has changed since then, you will be able to [apply](#) for the waiver beginning on **February 9**.

## **March**

- Mar. 20 - Registration Fee Payment deadline for Spring 2026\*
- Mar. 20 - First Spring TRIP installment due date and last day to enroll in Spring TRIP with early enrollment fee
- Mar. 20 - Deadline to submit Third Party Financial Guarantees for Spring 2026
- Mar. 20 - [Health Fee Waiver Application](#) late waiver deadline
- Mar. 21 - Actual Financial Aid Disbursements
- Mar. 24 - Financial aid refunds begin processing
- Mar. 30 - First day of classes/late registration fee payment deadline (to avoid being dropped from classes)
- Mar. 31 - Students with outstanding balances of fees and tuition will be dropped from Spring 2026 classes

\* Note: We recommend waiting until the March eBill is generated on Mar. 5 to ensure all relevant charges (including Housing) are on your account before making your payment.

## **April**

- April 3 - TritonPay monthly eBill statement available
  - April 10 - Deadline to apply for part-time status for reduced tuition and freeze date (deadline for students to add or re-enroll in classes via WebReg)
  - April 24 - TritonPay monthly eBill statement due date and second Spring TRIP installment due date
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- April 24 - Last day to enroll in TRIP for Spring Quarter
